Policies

-) Players must sign in before play.
-) Courts are first-come, first-served after your full group arrives.
-) Assignments are 1 1/2 hours for 4 players, 1 hour for 2 or 3 players.
-) Players must use available courts, and not ask other players to vacate their court.
-) If all courts are in use, players must wait 15 minutes after exiting their court before they sign up to play again.
-) **Juniors:** no play before noon Sat/Sun/Hol if adult members are waiting.

Guests

-) **Members' Guests: \$20/day**
-) **Drop-In Guests: \$25/day**
-) **"Free play"** available pre-season & post-season except weekend mornings

No one may be a guest more than 5 days/season. Members must identify their guests at the desk before playing.

Certificate Refund

A certificate holder who wishes to resign from the Club must mail a letter of resignation by May 15th to be eligible for a refund the same year, and may not play as an annual member for two seasons. Refund availability is determined by the club in late Fall. Funds identified as available after all outstanding obligations have been satisfied will be divided among those eligible for refunds.

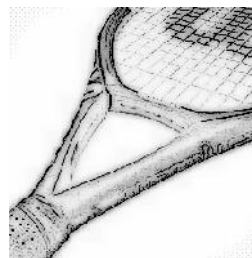
